

- Beef weigh-in and tag in- March 9 from 9am to 11am at the WyCo Fair Grounds
- Small Livestock tag-in: May 1 from 5:30pm to 7:30pm and May 11 from 9am to noon at the WyCo Fair Grounds
- Project selections in 4-H Online deadline- May 1
- Non-Market/breeding livestock animal Project ID forms due to the 4-H Office- May 1
  - Project ID forms are available on the Extension Office website
- Copy of completed YQCA certificates sent to 4-H Office-June 15



### **YQCA Information**

All youth who plan to exhibit livestock in the 4-H classes at the Wyandotte County Fair must have completed the Youth for the Quality Care of Animals certification (YQCA) through an inperson or online course and send a copy of the certificate the 4-H Agent by **June 15**.

Email a copy of the YQCA certificate to csling@ksu.edu by **June 15** to be eligible to show a livestock animal in 4-H classes.
