## Stipulations for Wyandotte County 4-H Council Scholarships

- Youth must be enrolled in Wyandotte County 4-H through ks.4honline.com with an active profile including enrollment in a primary 4-H Club, at least one 4-H Project and have paid 4-H Program Fee or received waiver through Kansas 4-H Foundation.
- The funds are to be used for 4-H sponsored events only.
- The scholarship cannot exceed fifty percent of the cost of the activity and no more than \$100.00.
- Youth should attend at least fifty percent of their club 4-H meetings and or project meetings (this information can be verified by club leader or project leader)
- Only one scholarship per person per 4-H year.
- The Finance committee would like to meet you! Please come to the next meeting and let us know why you want a scholarship. If you cannot attend, please make a short video and send it to us.
- Youth should participate in at least 10 community service hours per year.
- Youth should serve on at least one committee or officer position in a county, club, or project group. (Beginning in 2020)
- Youth should have participated in the previous year's 4-H sponsored fund raiser. (Beginning in year 2020)

Scholarship Applications should be turned in four weeks prior to when funds are needed for events to 4-H Council Finance Committee Adult Chair.
