### 2022 - 2023 VOLUNTEER GOALS

Club & Project leaders should aim to start (or even continue) making progress on the below 5 goals. I am more than happy to support or talk through each of these goals for your group of 4-H'ers.

- Clubs should hold at least 9 meetings throughout the year. Projects should aim to host at least 4 meetings throughout the year.
- Include at least 1 experiential learning experience (invite a guest speaker, take a field trip, etc)
- Host or participate in 1 community service project as a club/project.
- Increase club representation at county events (outside of just fair).
